

How to Install USB Drivers for RainLOG ™ 2.0

USB to serial port adapters require drivers to be installed to ensure proper operation. RainWise products all use FTDI drivers.

Verifying Correct Driver Installation:

- 1. Open the computers 'Device Manager.' The location of 'Device manager' depends on the version of Windows you are running.
- For Windows 7, click the Start button and enter "device manager" into the search box.
- For Windows XP, click Start, click Control Panel, click Performance and Maintenance, and then click System. On the Hardware tab, click 'Device Manager.'
- 2. Connect the adaptor USB cable to the computer. The Device manager will refresh automatically. Look for a section called "Com & LPT Ports". Expand it to view installed devices.
- 3. If the driver is installed, you will see an item listed as 'USB Serial Port' with a comport number listed in parenthesis. This is the number you must select in the appropriate software.
- 4. If you do not see 'Com & LPT Ports' or you can't find a USB Serial Port listed, your driver is not installed correctly.

 - Look for the words "setup executable" in the comments of the table. This link will allow you to download an automatic driver installer.
- 5. Download and run the installer. Remove and reconnect the USB cable and recheck the Device Manager.
 - Remember that a new comport number is assigned for each physical USB port on the computer. Try to use the same port each time.
